

*K-LIRT's 2005 Summer Workshop:
Creating Tutorials with Camtasia Studio*

SYNOPSIS:

K-LIRT's 2005 Summer Workshop: Creating Tutorials with Camtasia Studio was held Friday, July 22nd, 2005 in the Hemisphere Room of Kansas State University's Hale Library. A total of 33 people attended the workshop. There were 3 presenters and also 9 assistants who provided one-on-one help throughout the day.

The morning session began at 9:30 a.m. with a 30 minute presentation by Linda Wapelhorst from Butler Community College. She discussed the value of visual tutorials and provided advice and numerous tips for constructing them. Sarah Silva from Kansas State University's Information Technology Assistance Center then led the attendees for three hours through the step-by-step process of creating a short tutorial using Camtasia Studio. In the training, she demonstrated how to do the following: set the region of the screen to be captured, record a screen-capture, extend captured frames, add callouts to extended frames, add narration, and render a video.

The afternoon session began at 1:30 p.m., following lunch in the Bluemont Room of the K-State Union. Sarah's training concluded at 2:30 p.m. The attendees then worked from 2:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. to create a tutorial of their own design. During this time, Jason Coleman distributed door prizes and presented a brief comparison of three popular screen recording programs.
