

KLA Interlibrary Loan Round Table (KILR) Report

The major activities of the KLA Interlibrary Loan Round Table (KILR) between August and October 2004 included the following:

1. A fall meeting/program of KILR was held during the Kansas Interlibrary Loan Council (KIC) fall meeting on October 6, 2004 at the Hutchinson Public Library. More than 60 interlibrary loan librarians and staff in the state attended the program. Cecilia Hddleston, KILR chair-elect, recruited three wonderful speakers: Teresa Coble from Library/Archives Division, Kansas State Historical Society, Debbie Greeson, from Interlibrary Loan Division of Kansas Historical Society, and Brenda Cash, Head of Interlibrary Loan Department of SEKLS. Their topics concentrated on how to get genealogy materials from ILL and from the Kansas State Historical Society.
2. During the KILR fall meeting/program, attendees participated in discussions and offered input on a KILR program for the 2005 Tri-Conference. Genealogy research, mentoring new ILL staff, and OCLC Connexion training on ILL modules were some examples that participants would like to see among the Tri-Conference programs.
3. Cecilia Huddleston, chair-elect, submitted a KILR program to the 2005 Tri-Conference: "How can ILLers state-wide help everyone learn resulting in improved resource sharing? Why training and mentoring, of course!" The program will have some experts to share their training and mentoring experience, and on lessons/feedback on what works and what does not.
